City Wall presents Dellow's "Extravagance EP". Dellow is the next new talent to release on CWR in 2011. Dellow's blend of classic uplifting trance is mainly inspired by the scene's big guns, the likes of Tiesto, Armin Van Buuren, Ferry Corsten, Above and Beyond etc. In fact Dellow even has a pair of Tiesto's own branded shoes!

Dellow is a young maestro completely self-taught by online You-Tube tutorials and he represents the "next generation" of trance pioneers. His forte is in crafting massive progressive uplifting synth lines but also always wants that extra bit of "sparkle" in his music. Which I think you'll agree there is no doubt it has.

### **Momentum (Original Mix)** ▶

Momentum has a bright, sparkly classic vibe that will appeal especially to those who want that mainstream trance sound. Super SFX add spice but it is the lead synth that will leave ravers thinking "I know that tune from somewhere". Needless to say that this one has huge "big room" dancefloor potential.

### **Star Strike (Original Mix)** ▶

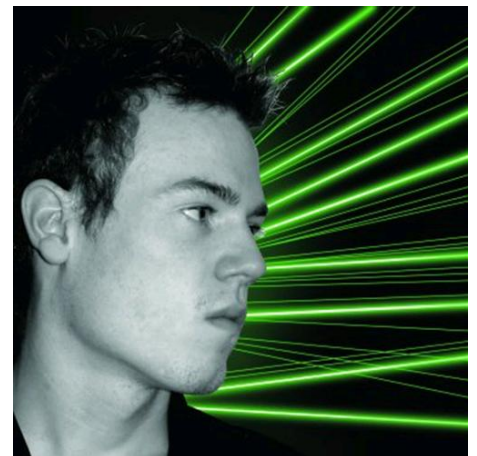
A solid DJ friendly intro with quality warmth in the bassline and strings, but it is the happy melodic sequence that in true Dellow style grows and progresses into a strong main theme. The breakdown sees the second counter lead take control and this takes Star Strike to the next level.

### **Sun Seeker (Original Mix)** ▶

Sun Seeker shows a deeper side to Dellow's production talent. The darker synth lines are well complimented by the uplifting melodies and strings. Great amplitude contrasts in the breakdown really build exciting tension before the drop. This is epic journeying melodic trance at its best.

### **Extravagance (Original Mix)** ▶

Super heavy weight kick drums coupled with strong high end percussives lead the way to what can only be described as an absolutely monstrous synth lead build. The need to "gulp" quells as this track opens up to the breakdown. A beautifully intense string pad combo leads to the strong, strong drop that is sure to create dancefloor pandemonium. Not for the feint hearted, this is a perfect "end of set" masterpiece.
