This package really exemplifies the diversity of Nelman's talent. He seems just 'at home' making melodic trance as he does hard techno. Created as a special tribute to his beautiful baby daughter, the original melody was penned using an antique Gebrüder Stingl Wien piano but what really strikes me is the rich attention to detail on the synth work that brings out real emotive depth. This creates a certain haunting mysticism to the collection that takes me back to some of the classics found on the 'Reactivate' series from the now defunct React Records. Nelman also has a host of darker techno releases coming up on a variety of labels and his work is seeing support from the likes of Tosi, Stevie Wilson, Dj Ninna V, Paulo Alvarado, De Hessejung, Tuomas Rantanen, Israel Toledo, Steve Kyri, John Overblast, Tim Müller, Mike Bronner, Patrex and many more...



1. Jasmine (Original Mix) ▶

A strong framework is laid and each element given its place.

2. Jasmine (Mix A) ▶

More room given to the piano melody here with an overall lighter feel.

3. Jasmine (Mix B) ▶

Heavier kick drums pound and a crisper snare with added layering on the synths.

4. Jasmine (Mix C) ▶

The longest mix with a stretched intro and slightly different pitched bassline.
